





TRANS & GENDER VARIANT YOUTH

2017 LGBTQ Youth survey shows us **trans** smoking rates are...



32%

higher than those of LGB youth.

Youth self-describing as non-binary also had statistically significant higher smoking rates.







- □ Have options for an all-gender bathroom (+ locker room)?
